Guidelines for Victory Credit Union Educational Award

Victory Credit Union will be offering up to three educational awards of up to \$1,000.00.

To be eligible the applicant must meet the following criteria:

- 1) Applicant or immediate member of applicant's household must be a Victory Credit Union Member for a minimum of one year.
- 2) Applicant must be a graduating student of Avon View High School or Hants North Rural High School.
- 3) Applicant must be actively involved as a volunteer within their community.
- 4) Applicant must be accepted into post-secondary education.

The criteria for selection of awards are listed below and are weighted equally:

- 1) Academic achievement
- 2) Co-operative community service (volunteer work)
- 3) Financial need
- 4) Success in spite of extraordinary circumstances

To apply for the VCU Educational Award:

- 1) Applicant must complete the VCU Post Secondary Educational Award Application. Copies may be found with the school guidance counselor or by visiting www.victorycreditunion.ca
- 2) Applicant must provide all information stated on the application form.
- 3) Deadline for submission is May 28, 2021.

Late entries will be not be accepted for consideration.

Proof of acceptance to post-secondary education must be presented to VCU prior to funds being disbursed to recipient.

Funds will be made payable to recipient and the university or community-college applicant is attending.
